TRANSITION CHECKLIST

(Steps for Ages 16-17)





Get a Colorado ID from the <u>Department of Motor Vehicles</u>
Discuss jobs & take opportunities to shadow. Consider <u>SWAP</u> for work support
Begin to teach meal preparation, shopping, and kitchen safety
Grow in independence by ordering for themselves at a restaurant, making
appointments, etc. as able
Learn to use phone, email, social media, etc. safely and responsibly
Learn address and phone numbers and what to do in an emergency
Consider/discuss <u>Inclusive Higher Education</u> and visit campuses
Encourage youth to direct more personal care, as able
Discuss management of & ability to communicate diagnoses and needs
Age 17:
Begin to ask case managers about adult waivers. Ask for a <u>waiver chart</u>
Open a bank account with the primary caregiver's name on the account
Discuss with your IEP team, if the transition program is an option
If IDD, schedule the <u>Supports Intensity Scale</u> to determine budget for services
Ask medical providers when they transition to adult care-create a plan
Discuss with youth about future goals, living arrangements, work, etc.
Learn about <u>Program Approved Services Agencies</u> that provide HCBS services
Consider <u>Guardianship</u> , <u>Power of Attorney</u> , and/or Supported Decision Making

TRANSITION CHECKLIST

(Steps for Age 18)



Register to vote
If a male, sign up with <u>selective services</u>
Apply for an Adult HCBS waiver with Case Management Agency
Meet with case manager to ask about services under the chosen HCBS waiver
Explore and visit adult day programs and get on wait list, if appropriate
Apply for <u>Supplemental Security Income</u> , if not already receiving
Create a room and board document to agree on rent
Get wisdom teeth out, new equipment, etc before Medicaid EPSDT ends at 21
Open an <u>ABLE account</u> and/or Special Needs Trust
